

Federation

The Federation of Lutheran Churches of Cincinnati and Vicinity is an association of congregations in the Greater Cincinnati area affiliated with the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod. It began operating in 1921.

Since it is a “federation” of congregations, individual members of congregations comprising the Federation are also members, individually, of the Federation.

The objectives of the Federation are:

- To foster Christian fellowship & love
- To do institutional mission work
- To do social welfare work
- To advance the cause of Christian education
- To sponsor joint gatherings and group promotional activities of importance to the Lutheran Church.
- To conduct all such other work as would tend to the glory of God and the welfare of mankind.

The Federation has three salaried employees, one minister and one deaconess serving as chaplains at University Hospital, and one coordinator of campus ministry.
